USER INFORMATION

User Information shall be provided to the user of the product. NFPA Standard 1983 recommends separating the User Information from the equipment and retaining the information in a permanent record. The standard also recommends making a copy of the User Information to keep with the equipment and that the information should be referred to before and after each use.

Additional information regarding life safety equipment can be found in NFPA 1500, *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Programs*, and NFPA 1983, *Standard on Life Safety Rope and Equipment for Emergency Services*.

ABOUT THROWLINE

CMC NFPA Throwline is designed to fulfill the NFPA 1983 definition of a Throwline as "a floating rope that is intended to be thrown to a person during water rescues or as a tether for rescuers entering the water."

REQUIREMENTS FOR SAFE USE

Protect the rope from abrasion during storage and while carrying. During use, protect the rope from any sharp or abrasive edges by padding the edges or rigging the rope to avoid the edges. CMC NFPA Throwline should not be exposed to flame or high temperature. Carry the rope where it will be protected from melting or burning due to exposure to high heat or flame.

INSPECTION

CMC NFPA Throwline should be inspected periodically to verify that the rope is in a serviceable condition. Look for cuts, abrasions, or fuzzy areas that would indicate the rope has been used or exposed to abrasion or sharp edges. If the rope does not pass inspection or if there is any doubt about the safety or serviceability of the rope, remove the rope from service and destroy it.
